

# JOHN CROOK CULINARY ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded in memory of John Crook to two graduating high school seniors of **Edgar County** planning to further their education at any recognized 4-year college or university. This scholarship is a field of interest scholarship in the food education industry, such as culinary arts, dietary training, etc... This scholarship is **non-renewable**.

The primary eligibility will be based on the following criteria:

- \_\_\_ 1. 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) as indicated by transcripts
- \_\_\_ 2. Household demographics
- \_\_\_ 3. Personal Essay
- \_\_\_ 4. Financial need
- \_\_\_ 5. Recommendations

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. The committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members of the applicants involved in the selection process.
