

Kiwanis Early Risers Scholarship

This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior of Edgar County planning to further his/her education in any recognized 2 or 4-year college or university in Illinois or Indiana.

The primary eligibility will be based on the following criteria:

- ___ 1. GPA as indicated by high school transcripts
- ___ 2. Top 25% of Graduating class
- ___ 3. ACT or SAT scores
- ___ 4. Extracurricular activities
- ___ 5. Community activities
- ___ 6. Volunteering
- ___ 7. Household demographics
- ___ 8. Personal Essay
- ___ 9. Financial Need
- ___ 10. Recognition as an Illinois State Scholar (optional)
- ___ 11. Recommendations
 - Two Teachers
 - Two Community

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. The committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members of the applicants involved in the selection process.
