

# TOM HEBERMEHL VOCATIONAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors or post graduates of Paris Cooperative High School planning to further their education at a vocational school, junior college, or business college, each seeking a 2-year associate degree. The scholarship is renewable for a second year of study.

The primary eligibility will be based on the following criteria:

## Check List

- 1. Financial need
- 2. Good attendance
- 3. Community activities
- 4. School activities
- 5. Future plans essay
- 6. ACT or SAT scores

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members or relatives involved in the selection process. Tom Hebermehl will anonymously review the top 5 finalists to help determine the three recipients.
