This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in memory of Brian Evans Cooper and the Cooper Family to a high school senior or a recent high school graduate of **Paris High School** who seeks to further their education at any recognized 4-year college or university. The successful applicant will have an educational focus in the areas of the sciences or engineering, history, or nutrition. Special consideration will be given to students with interests related to climate change or social justice. This scholarship is **renewable** for up to five years of continued higher education, including post-graduate work. Successful completion of each year of study and maintaining a major (or postgraduate focus) in a qualifying discipline is required for all payments to be distributed to the awardee.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for ANY ECCF scholarships:

- 1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
- 2. Submit high school and college transcripts (if a college student)
 transcripts **must include 1st semester grades for current school year**
- 3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **Brian Evans Cooper and Cooper Family Scholarship:**

- 1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
- 2. Be a **high school senior** or a postgraduate from **Paris High School**
- 3. Attend a recognized 4-year college or university
- 4. Pursue courses in engineering, history, or nutrition (special consideration for climate change or social justice)
- 5. ACT or SAT scores will be considered
- 6. Have been involved in extracurricular activities, community activities, and volunteering

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members or relatives involved in the selection process.
