

# CVJ ENGLUM VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Five \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors from any **Edgar County** high school planning to further their education in a tech/vocational degree ranging anywhere from Agriculture to Veterinary assistant/technician. Past recipients may **reapply**.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for **ANY** ECCF scholarships:

1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
2. Submit high school and college transcripts (if a college student)  
\*\*transcripts **must** include 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades for current school year\*\*
3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **CVJ Englum Vocational Scholarship**:

1. Submit **ALL** paperwork from the above list
2. Be a **high school senior** from any **Edgar County** high school
3. Postgraduates who are **past winners** may apply.
4. Pursue tech/vocational school degree ranging anywhere from **agriculture to veterinary assistant/technician**
5. Primary eligibility will be based upon **financial need**
6. GPA of **3.3-4.5**
7. Have been involved in extracurricular activities, community activities, and volunteering
8. ACT or SAT scores will be considered

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members or relatives involved in the selection process.
