This \$500 scholarship will be awarded in memory of John Crook to two graduating high school seniors from **Edgar County** high schools planning to further their education at any recognized 4-year college or university. This scholarship is a field of interest scholarship in the food education industry, such as culinary arts, dietary training, family and consumer science etc... This scholarship is **non-renewable**.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for **ANY** ECCF scholarships:

1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
2. Submit high school transcripts
transcripts **must include 1st semester grades for the current school year**
3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **John Crook Family & Consumer Science Scholarship**:

1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
2. Be a high school senior from any **Edgar County** high school
3. Attend a recognized 4-year college or university
4. Further their education in the food education industry such as, culinary arts, dietary training, family and consumer science, etc....
5. Have a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) as indicated by transcripts
6. A need based on household demographics and financial need will be considered

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. The committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members of the applicants involved in the selection process.
