

JOSEPH E. & DOROTHY ARCHER EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$4,800 scholarship will be awarded each year to a qualifying student who is a graduating senior of **Paris High School** and meets the established criteria. The \$4,800 will be awarded in increments of \$1,200 per year for four years provided the student remains in good standing at the selected institution of higher learning.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for **ANY** ECCF scholarships:

1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
2. Submit high school transcripts
transcripts **must include 1st semester grades for the current school year**
3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **Joseph E. and Dorothy Archer Educational Scholarship**:

1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
2. A high school senior from **Paris High School**
3. Must be a resident in the **Elbridge Township of Edgar County** as established by the Illinois School Code
4. Must be accepted to and attend one of the following educational institutions: Rose Hulman, Indiana State University, St. Mary's of the Woods, Purdue University, Indiana University, and Ivy Tech Community College of Terre Haute, Indiana
5. Have been involved in extracurricular activities, community activities, and volunteering
6. A need based on household demographics will be considered
7. Junior and senior year transcripts will be highly considered

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be composed of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be composed of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family or relatives involved in the selection process. At the conclusion of the selection process the applicant will be notified. Scholarship awards will be made directly to the chosen university upon completion of the 1st semester work. The applicant must be in good academic standing. The remaining year awards will be presented to the applicant upon confirmation of registration and academic standing.
