This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior from an **Edgar County** high school planning to further his/her education in the field of **science**. This scholarship is **renewable** for up to 4 years, provided the student <u>remains</u> in the field of science.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for **ANY** ECCF scholarships:

- 1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
- 2. Submit high school transcripts

 transcripts **must include 1st semester grades for the current school year**
- 3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **Morrisey Family Scientific Careers Scholarship:**

- 1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
- 2. Be a high school senior from any **Edgar County** high school
- 3. Further their education in the field of **science**
- 4. GPA in science courses will be evaluated
- 5. Financial need or household demographics will be considered
- 6. Letter of acceptance to an accredited college or university will be required

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. The committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members of the applicants involved in the selection process. At the conclusion of the selection process, the Morrisey family will review the top applicants, confer with the committee to select a final recipient, and present the award to the recipient.
