

# TOM HEBERMEHL VOCATIONAL SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

Three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors or postgraduates of **Paris High School** planning to further their education at a vocational school, junior college, or business college, each seeking a 2-year associate degree. The scholarship is renewable for a **second year of study**.

Applicants must submit the following items when applying for **ANY** ECCF scholarships:

1. Complete scholarship application on ECCF website
2. Submit high school and college transcripts (if a college student)  
\*\*transcripts **must** include 1<sup>st</sup> semester grades for current school year\*\*
3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **VFW Post 3601 Veterans Scholarship**:

1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
2. Be a high school senior or postgraduate of **Paris High School**
3. Attending a vocational school, junior college, business college seeking a **2-year associate degree**
4. A financial need will be considered
5. Good school attendance will be considered
6. Have been involved in extracurricular activities, community activities, and volunteering
7. ACT or SAT scores will be considered

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be comprised of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be comprised of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family members or relatives involved in the selection process. Tom Hebermehl will anonymously review the top 5 finalists to help determine the three recipients.
