 transcripts **must include 1st semester grades for current school year**
- 3. Submit SAT or ACT scores

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **William D. Ingrum Memorial Scholarship:**

- 1. Submit ALL paperwork from the above list
- 2. Be a high school senior or postgraduate from Paris High School
- 3. Further their education by seeking an associate degree at any recognized junior college
- 4. The primary eligibility will be based upon **financial need**
- 5. A need based on household demographics will be considered
- 6. Have been involved in extracurricular activities, community activities, and volunteering
- 7. GPA as indicated by transcripts will be considered

The selection will be articulated by a committee authorized by the Edgar County Community Foundation Scholarship Coordinator. This committee may be composed of teachers, community, church or professional leaders dedicated to the enrichment of education. The committee may be composed of 3, 5, or 7 members with no family or relatives involved in the selection process. At the conclusion of the selection process, the Ingrum family will review and present the awards to the recipients in a manner of their choosing that best represents the memorial.
